S u m m e r i s h e r e ! It is the time of year that more attention is put on outside yard and garden projects. What a wonderful time to invite family and friends over to relax and enjoy the beauty of this season. ***But is your front entrance to your home inviting or is it giving the impression for people to stay away?***

Here are three simple secrets to creating a welcoming place for both you and your guests.

1. Attract abundance to your home by creating a grand entrance.

Your front entrance is known as the mouth of chi (energy). Be sure that your entrance is not blocked by overgrowing or spiky-leafed plants.

2. Plant flowers in the front garden of your home to attract positive yang energy to your dwelling.

Using any shade of red from soft pink and bright fuchsia to deeper tones of burgundy and dark reds will encourage yang energy into your home.

3. Use artwork, rather than a mirror directly across from the entrance of your home.

A mirror allows the chi or vital energy to reflect back out the door as it enters the home, instead of allowing it to come in and flow throughout your place.
